



APIS QUICK QUERY (AQQ) SOLUTION

AQOSENT is a complete web application solution that offers online access to the US Department of Homeland Security (DHS) server for the vetting of passengers.

It enables carriers to comply with the new APIS Pre-Departure requirements that are mandatory for all carriers transporting passengers into, out of or within the United States.

The new rule combines the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) No-Fly/Selectee (NFL/SL) screening and the Bureau for Customs and Border Protection's (CBP) APIS Plus into a One DHS Solution.

ICTS Europe Systems, Part of ICTS Europe, which has been providing NFL/SL screening and APIS Plus collection and transmission services, is now offering a solution that complies with the new requirement.

The stand-alone, easily mobile AQOSENT boxes can be deployed in any airport, in any country, with no advance preparation or connected and triggered from an existing departure control system.

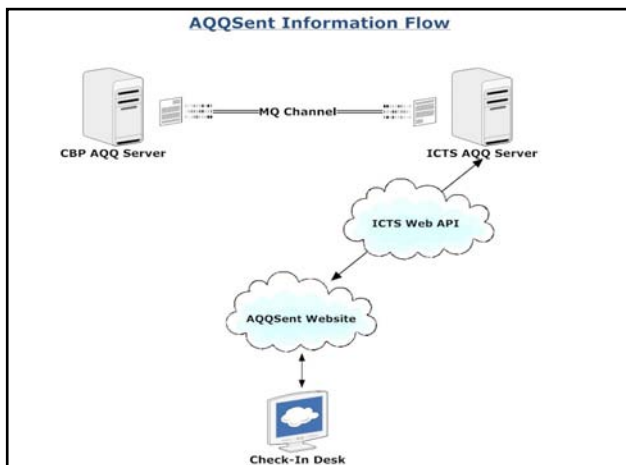

- AQQSent can be triggered and used from any Check-in desk with an internet connection
- Web site integration can be achieved via HTTP Post or parameterised URL submission
- MRZ reader support
- Can also be implemented as a Web-services interface (API) integrated with the carrier's check-in/kiosks systems
- Run directly from any Check-in desk with an Internet connection and MRZ Reader, or directly from an AQQSent laptop.
